Submission Guidelines:

Papers must be submitted by March 1, 2025. Manuscripts should be prepared according to the guideline given in the "Information for Authors". The latest version is available at the web site, <http://www.ite.or.jp/content/MTA/#IFA>. Authors should write "Special Section: KIBME-ITE Joint Special Section" in the cover letter and choose the [Special Section] as a "Section Type" on the online screen. Do not choose [Regular]. The term for revising the manuscript after acknowledgement of conditional acceptance for this special section could be shorter than that for other regular issues (30 days) because of the tight review schedule.
